



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POLICY ON IMPLANTABLE PROSTHESES MANAGEMENT

1.0 PURPOSE

- 1.1 To ensure that all implantable prostheses are available whenever required for patient care.
 - 1.2 To ensure that implantable prostheses are stored in a manner that maintains their sterility and integrity.
 - 1.3 To ensure that the **batch number and serial number** of all implantable prostheses used are accurately recorded in the patient's medical records.

2.0 SCOPE

- 2.1 This policy applies to **all implantable prostheses procured and used for patient care** in the hospital.

3.0 RESPONSIBLE PERSONS

- 3.1 Operating Doctor / Treating Consultant
 - 3.2 Medical Superintendent
 - 3.3 Pharmacy Manager
 - 3.4 Pharmacists

4.0 POLICY

4.1 Implantable prostheses and medical devices used in the hospital shall be **selected based on scientific criteria** and in accordance with **national and international guidelines**.

4.2 **Quality certificates** for all implantable prostheses and medical devices shall be maintained by the hospital.

4.3 All implantable prostheses used in the hospital shall meet the following selection criteria:

- 4.3.1 The implant shall have **FDA approval, CE certification**, or other recognized quality certification from a reputed organization.
- 4.3.2 The implant shall be associated with **minimal post-operative complications**.
- 4.3.3 The implant shall be of **appropriate size**.
- 4.3.4 The implant shall be suitable for the **age and clinical condition of the patient**.

4.4 Patients and their family members shall be **counseled by the treating consultant** regarding:

- The use of implantable prostheses and medical devices
- Expected benefits and possible risks

4.5 **Post-procedure precautions** related to the implantable prosthesis shall be clearly explained to the patient by the treating consultant.

4.6 The **batch number and serial number** of implantable prostheses used shall be recorded in the following:

- 4.6.1 Patient's medical record
- 4.6.2 Master Operation Theatre (OT) register
- 4.6.3 Patient's discharge card
