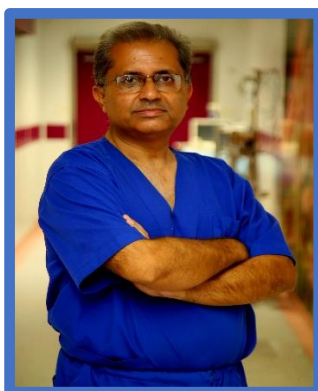


Bio-Brief: Prof. (Dr.) Vineet Mahajan



1. **Dr. Vineet Mahajan** has assumed charge as the **Medical Superintendent** of the All India Institute of Medical Sciences (AIIMS), Guwahati, on 2nd April 2026.
2. **Dr. Mahajan** is a distinguished academician, clinician, and healthcare administrator in the field of Cardiothoracic and Vascular Surgery. He completed his M.Ch. in Cardiothoracic and Vascular Surgery from Grant Medical College, University of Mumbai. He further enhanced his clinical expertise by acquiring advanced fellowships in Cardiac Surgery from Narayana Hrudayalaya, Bangalore and Thoracic Surgery from NITRD, New Delhi.

In addition to his surgical qualifications, **Dr. Mahajan** is formally trained in healthcare management and administration. He holds a recognized Master of Business Administration (MBA) degree in Healthcare Management, equipping him with a strong foundation in hospital administration, policy implementation, and healthcare systems management. He played a key leadership role in securing NABH and JCI accreditation of various hospitals.

Following the completion of his education, **Dr. Mahajan** served for a significant period at Narayana Institute of Cardiac Sciences, Bommasandra, Bengaluru, where he gained extensive clinical and academic experience and served under Rajiv Gandhi University of Health Sciences, Bengaluru, as Assistant Professor and later Associate Professor.

3. He was later appointed as Associate Professor at AIIMS Bhopal, where he contributed substantially to academic development, patient care services, and institutional growth. After his tenure at AIIMS Bhopal, he joined Rajendra Institute of Medical Sciences (RIMS), Ranchi—an autonomous institute—as Professor and Head of Cardiovascular and Thoracic Surgery, along with additional administrative responsibilities.

In early 2024, **Dr. Mahajan** joined AIIMS Guwahati as Professor and Head of Cardiothoracic and Vascular Surgery, a position he continues to hold alongside his current administrative role as Medical Superintendent.

4. **Dr. Mahajan** has also been actively involved at the international level. He has served as invited faculty in medical sciences at Johannesburg and has been associated with leading hospitals like Christiaan Bernard Memorial Hospital, Groote Schuur Hospital Cape Town, Mount Sinai Health System and Presbyterian Hospital, Manhattan, New York. He is also a visiting faculty at Clinica Biblica and Pacifica Salud in Latin America. He is recognized as a global leader on CTSNet, the world's leading platform for cardiothoracic surgery since 2005.

He is also instrumental in global organizations such as the International Society of Cardiomyopathies, Myocarditis and Heart Failure, and the International Society for Heart and Lung Transplantation.

His primary areas of clinical and academic interest include surgeries for heart failure and heart & lung transplantation. He has various publications in National & International journals to his credit. He is credited with innovating three surgical techniques in cardiac surgery.

He serves as an examiner for various universities across India and is a recognized faculty member and Professor of the National Board of Examinations in Medical Sciences, New Delhi. He has been actively involved in the accreditation and re-accreditation of hospitals for initiating and maintaining Cardiac, Vascular, and Thoracic surgery training programs under regulatory bodies such as the National Medical Commission (NMC) & National Board of Examinations in Medical Sciences (NBEMS), New Delhi.

He has trained approximately 10 M.Ch. students, many of whom are currently serving across India and abroad, contributing to the advancement of cardiothoracic and vascular surgery.
