

BIO BRIEF: COMMANDANT T NGAMLIEN, TM



1. Commandant T Ngamlien, TM (0693-X) joined Indian Coast Guard on 26 Dec 2006 as 47th batch Assistant Commandant (General Duty). After completion of Naval Oriental Course at Naval Academy, Goa, he had further undergone extensive professional trainings onboard various Navy and Coast Guard training ships and establishments.

Important appointments held by the officer include Commanding Officer of ICGS C-404 (Interceptor Boat) based in Beypore (Kerala), Commanding Officer of ICGS Rajkiran (Fast Patrol Vessel) based in Haldia (West Bengal) and later rebased to Port Blair, Executive Officer of ICGS Varaha (Offshore Patrol Vessel) based in New Mangalore (Karnataka), Staff Officer to the Regional Commander at Coast Guard Regional Headquarter (East), Chennai and Joint Director (Recruitment) at Coast Guard Headquarters, New Delhi.
3. The officer has an outstanding track record of operational successes and administrative prowess. Noteworthy operational achievements of the officer include rescue of six distressed/drowning fishermen who were clinging on to a sunken boat amidst inclement weather off Odisha Coast in June 2017 and also rescued 22 distressed crew of MV Kolkata, which was engulfed in a huge inferno amidst cyclonic weather condition off West Bengal Coast in June 2018. As Staff Officer, he had efficiently assisted two different Flag Officers in commissioning of multiple capital ships with VVIPs and foreign dignitaries in attendance and coordination of various maritime operations undertaken by Indian Coast Guard ships and aircraft including two separate operations to save crew of two super tankers engulfed in inferno in the waters of Sri Lanka.

In recognition of his outstanding achievements, the officer has been awarded the prestigious Tatrakshak Medal (Gallantry) along with an inked signed scroll from the President of India, DGICG Commendation for outstanding service, Bravery Award by ABP News, Best Search and Rescue Ship and Most Spirited Ship.
5. Commandant T. Ngamlien joined AIIMS Guwahati as Deputy Director (Administration) w.e.f. 17th September 2024 on deputation and is taking proactive role in streamlining of various administrative procedure in the nascent Institute of National Importance. Attention to details, strict adherence to rules and fast execution of jobs without compromising on quality are his mainstay as Administrator and Commander.
6. The officer's hobby include watching movies, playing badminton, golf, etc. The officer is married to Mrs. Boinu Hoineithem, who is a home maker and the couple is blessed with four sons.
